Obituary

Mr. Thomas Varghese of Kaipallimalil House was born on March 15, 1937 in Neerettupuram, Kerala. Before migrating to the United States in 1976, he began his career at Dunlop in Madras. He ran a small business for decades in Hyattsville, Maryland, supporting his family here and in India. He passed away after a brief struggle with Liver Cancer on November 13, 2012, at age 75.

Over 30 years ago, when the local Malayalee Christian community consisted of just a handful of families, Thomas Varghese was an integral force behind the creation of a now-vibrant St. Thomas Indian Orthodox Church of Greater Washington; from hosting Holy Liturgy in his living room to traveling across the country to raise funds to coordinating logistics like the use of a community hall for a decade, he was singularly tenacious in his pursuit of a unified, permanent, local church. He was devoted to his faith, his parish, and a community he loved to nurture.

Thomas Varghese leaves behind a long legacy of personal sacrifice, selfless service, and unconditional love, as well as a large family. He is survived by his wife of 45 years, Saramma; his three children, Mary Chacko (Veena), Vinu, and Vinoy; his son-in-law John Chacko and his daugher-in-law Kim Thomas; his grandchildren Anna, Alex, Cody, Justin, Jordan, and Jasmine; and his sisters, Annamma Job, Sosamma Varghese, Aleyamma Thomas, and Mariamma Koshy.
