# Annunciation to St. Mary



## Vicar's Message

Dearly Beloved ones in Christ,

Great Lent is the greatest fasting period in the church year in Orthodoxy. First of the six Sundays, beginning with the wedding feast of Cana, the church celebrates miracles of Jesus Christ and it ends with the healing of the blind man and raising of Lazarus from the dead on the Saturday before Palm Sunday. The seventh Sunday is Palm Sunday and the eighth Sunday, of course, is Easter. Each miracle performed by Jesus is a reminder for believers to grow in our faith and come closer to Him during this spiritual journey of Great Lent. 1st Sunday of Great Lent like we heard few weeks ago, was the miracle at the wedding feast in Cana, where we see the perfect trust of Mother Mary and obedience of the disciples. In the entire Bible, St. Mary the Mother of God speaks very few words. In the Gospel reading on "Kothine Sunday" she says: "Do whatever He tells you" and the miracle happens, water turns into fine wine. 2nd Sunday of Great lent, we commemorate the miracle of the healing of the leper. St. Luke's gospel says "And it came to pass when he was to a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy: who seeing Jesus fell on his face and besought him, saying, Lord, if you will, you can make me clean." Like this Leper who was confident that the Lord was able to cure him though his disease was so serious but he gave complete submission to God's will. This is the way of prayer expected from each of us to submit to His will.

3rd Sunday is the healing of the Paralytic, which actually teaches us the miracle of forgiveness and healing of the weakness performed by our Lord .An imperfect man in body and spirit was healed by the power of God not because of his own faith because of the faith of his friends. 4th Sunday of the Great lent commemorates the miracle of healing the Canaanite's daughter. This miracle is teaching us the persistence, the humility and the deepest faith of this woman. The question we must ask ourselves is do we give up our faith in God when He does not answer? Like the Psalmist says "Be silent and know that I am God". Listen to the Lord's silence and be persistent in your prayer. Likewise the Sundays after this remind believers of God's unconditional love and affection for humankind. Church is reminding her members to meditate on these Bible passages and potentially be healed inwardly and outwardly.

May God bless you all abundantly during this Great Lent.
