## 1. From Vicar's Desk

Dear and beloved Brethren,

By the grace of God we were able to pass yet another year and enter into a new year. This is the time to evaluate our past and make diligent decision to make our future life blessed and successful. In this evaluation, we should configure not only our demerits or flaws, but also our merits and success. Figuring out the demerits will help us to correct our weakness and figuring out the success will boost our confidence. So, both are important in our future. I would like to remind you a passage from St. Paul. *Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus* (Philippians 3: 12-14). We may have had lot of bitter experiences in the past year. Do not worry about that, because lot of holy men like St. Paul suffered more than us. St. Paul said *“therefore, I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ’s sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong”* (2 Corinthians 12: 10, 11). Moreover, Jesus Christ said, *“If the world hates you, you know that it hated me before it hated you.”* (John 15: 18). 3. Do not justify our faults (Is.5: 20-30).

5. Do not cling (over worry or over joy) on the past (Run for the future: Philippians 3: 12).
6. Be creative and positive (Take Hope in God: Colo. 1:27, 1Thes. 1:3)
7. Take refuge in God (Ps. 27:1).
8. Always, be thankful to God. (We should be always thankful to God because, without the grace of God we cannot do anything 1 Cor. 15:10, Ps. 127:1).
9. Do not hurt anybody under any circumstance.

### **Some parameters for deciding failure and success:**

1. Aim for success only through the right way.

2. Do not worry about failure when we go through the right way.
3. Be careful, there are lot of temptations that compel us to do unjust things.
4. Earning wealth is not the only measurement of success.
5. Success is not the victory over our enemy by defeating them with our muscle, money, intelligence, or our position. But defeat them with love and care.
6. Success is not what we have received from others, but success is how much we have given.
7. Success is peace, joy and eternal bliss.
8. Success is gaining a friend/ soul.
9. Success is obeying the will of God.
10. Success is not how much we talked but how much we kept in silence.
