The book of James which is one of the most practical books in the New Testament, gives us this great verse "consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. He exemplified grace, no revenge but gave full forgiveness. He discarded the wrongs of the past for the love for present and he exemplified faith and trust by believing that God is in control.

Dearly beloved, let's learn some virtues from our life experiences, let's not turn our anger into bitterness and revenge which can lead to self - destruction, rather lets develop a positive character out of it with the grace of our God. When you go through pains and heartaches of life, let's put full confidence in the goodness and plan of God so that it could become the building blocks on the journey of faith for you and me.
